The Bathe to Save Tour is a family of five Australians, Anthony, Rachel, Bella, Austin, Aria and their spokes-dog, Bubbles! After learning approximately 3.9 million animals are euthanized in U.S. shelters each year, the Amos family decided to travel across the country to raise awareness and save lives. Since January of 2016, they have been making stops in every state with their mobile HydroDog grooming unit. They are working to bathe 25,000 dogs and raise \$1million for animal rescues nationwide in partnership with GreaterGood.org and The Animal Rescue Site.

At 21, Anthony Amos founded the mobile dog grooming business, HydroDog. Within five years, HydroDog had grown to more than 100 franchises across Australia. Anthony and his team revolutionized the dog grooming industry by designing and creating a fiberglass mobile grooming salon in the shape of a big blue dog. At the age of 28, Anthony became one of Australia's youngest millionaires.
