## Homeward Pet's Holiday Pet Food Drive

**Woodinville, Wash**— Homeward Pet Adoption Center launches its 6th Annual Holiday Pet Food Drive on Friday, November 25th, 2016 and will run through December 31st, 2016. With over 20 local businesses hosting a food collection barrel, the shelter hopes to help even more families with pets this year. With more than 4 tons of dry pet food and 1500 cans of wet dog and cat food collected last year, Homeward Pet was able to feed hundreds of pets through partnerships with area food banks.
